## VISAKHAPATNAM

Visakhapatnam is a major Sea port on the east coast of India. With a population of approximately 5.36 million, it is the largest city in the state of Andhra Pradesh and the third largest city on the east coast of India after Kolkata and Chennai. Historically, the city is named after the god of Valour (Visakha) and is located 625 kilometers (388 miles) east of Hyderabad. It is often called The Jewel of the East Coast and 'the City of Destiny'. Nestled in the Eastern Ghats, the city opens to the Bay of Bengal to the east. Headquarters of the Eastern Naval Command of the Indian Navy is located in the city.

## VIZAG

Visakhapatnam, often called Vizag is a vibrant coastal city. Nestled between Eastern Ghats and Bay of Bengal, Visakhapatnam is known for its scenic beaches, lush hills, cultural heritage and rapidly growing infrastructure.
